

OLD HOME WEEK PARADE 2019

Rules and Regulations

Safety of both parade participants and the public is our #1 priority.

- Please wait at the Carleton Mall area until directed to move onto Deakin Drive at approximately 1:30 PM, with parade start at 2:00 PM. Walking units such as bands will be introduced into the parade at the intersection of Deakin Drive and Main Street.
- Protective gear with some entries (ATV, motorcycle and bicycle helmet, skateboarder knee and elbow pads, etc.) must be worn by parade participants. ATV's, golf carts, must be loaded onto trailers at parade end and not driven through traffic back to parade start area
- **NO** throwing of candy from any float or vehicle. If you wish to hand out candy, water, or brochures, this **MUST** be provided by walkers beside your entry.
- Vehicle drivers must never use their cellphone during the parade and watch out for children who may run in front or beside your motorized unit.
- **NO** spraying of water onto parade viewers
- Do not litter.
- **PLEASE** keep the parade moving forward. If your participation requires a demonstration, it should be short to not have gaps between your unit and the group in front of you.
- Your entry **MUST** be respectful of family values and your actions and behaviour in public must be acceptable. Failure to abide by this could result in your entry being asked to withdraw from the parade.
- Please be respectful of the volume of your music. If your unit will be playing music, please locate yourself in the parade a safe distance from the horses, ponies, etc. who are not accustomed to this environment. Parade officials will attempt to place your unit in the parade, before start, to respect this request.
- **Funeral:** In the event a funeral service is in progress at Scott's Funeral Home, your music must be turned off in that vicinity out of respect for the family.
- Participants are to disband at the end of parade – Main and King Street intersection or at NBCC.
- **NOTE:** Parade Spotters: In the event of an emergency, parade spotters with cell phones will be stationed along the route. If you hear a siren and it is not parade related, move to the right of the street to permit these vehicles rapid access to their destination. These Spotters are responsible to keep the parade moving and have the authority to remove your entry if deemed necessary.
